Counterfeit Shipping Containers

A counterfeit shipping container (also known as a fake, cloned or re-birthed container) is a container that has had its unique identifier erased from its exterior and replaced with that of another legitimate containers unique identifier.

The counterfeit container can then be used as a substitute for the copied container and may be used to facilitate a range of border related offences.

Below is a list of indicators to look out for and report to Border Watch:

- Repainted display numbers
- Alterations to corner castings
- Display numbers do not match plate or casting number
- Evidence of grinding of the corner casting
- Original numbers partially hidden or showing through

- Container Safety Plate or Manufacturers
 Plate damaged altered or replaced
- Any evidence of an attempt to replace serial numbers
- Incorrect placement of container number
