Introduction of the Containerchain Booking System for Empty, Laden & ISO Containers

DP World Logistics Australia would like to advise all container transport operators that we will be implementing the Containerchain empty and laden container booking system at our Park 1 (1890 Botany Road, Botany) and Park 2 (4 Bumborah Point Road Port Botany) Intermodal facilities.

This initiative will continue to provide transport operators with real-time visibility of our capacity and utilisation, as well as visibility of a significant amount of operational information that will assist to you with planning your daily operations. The new system will go live on **Friday 1 June 2018**. From this date, Container Transport Operators (CTO's) will need to have a valid notification from Containerchain to be serviced at DP World Logistics.

DP World Logistics will cease all gate operations at **10.00pm on Thursday 31 May 2018** and complete the transition to Containerchain by **2.00am on Friday 1 June 2018**. We will reopen for container movements from **6.00am on Friday 1 June**. "Container Notification" or "Container Pick-up Advice" bookings will be available from **2.00am on Friday 1 June**. No bookings will be accessible through Modal/1-Stop for any slots from **10.00pm on Thursday 31 May**. All valid Shipping Line export release numbers will be transitioned to the Containerchain system during the above outage window. DP World Logistics and Containerchain will have additional staff available on site from next week, to support any Transport Operator needs.

WHAT DO TRANSPORT OPERATORS NEED TO DO? *If you already have an active transport operator account with Containerchain in Sydney, you do not need to register again.*

All transport operators are required to set up an account at www.containerchain.com.au to enable access to online bookings for:

- 1. The Return of Empty Containers by creating a Container Return Advice Notification
- 2. The Pick Up of Empty Containers by creating a Container Pick-Up Advice Notification
- 3. The Return of Laden Containers or ISO tanks by creating a Container Notification
- 4. The Pick-up of Laden Containers or ISO tanks by creating a Container Pick-Up Advice

Drivers will need to provide a handover advice at the time of processing for any container **not** electronically pre- advised by the shipping Line (i.e. redirections). It will be a prerequisite to create Notifications via the Containerchain website prior to truck arrival at DP World Logistics Intermodal facilities.

From Friday 1 June 2018, a fee **\$8.00 + GST** will continue to apply to each notification made. From Sunday 1 July 2018, a fee of **\$12.00 + GST** will apply to each notification made. From Sunday 1 July 2018, DPWLA will also introduce penalties for early/late arrivals.
