





Subscriptions and Communication Channels

Subscription	Purpose	How to register
Industry Advice Notices (Import)	Provides information to the importing industry to advise of changes to legislation, procedural or importing requirements.	Register on the department’s website .
Industry Advice Notices (Export)	Provides information to the exporting industry to advise of changes to legislation, procedural or importing requirements.	Register on the department’s website .
BICON Alerts	Provides information about notices or changes to import conditions. You can keep informed with these notices by following individual import cases.	Create an account on the department’s website . An information card is available on the department’s website. Once registered users will be able to select the <i>How do I follow a case</i> task card from the help tab.
Department alerts and notices	Provides information about alerts or notices for specific areas of interest.	Create an account on the department’s website . Subscribe to specific pages of interest (Attachment A).
RSS Feeds 	An RSS feed is a simple method for staying informed about new content on a website. RSS feeds allow you to stay informed of the latest broadcasts from the sites you are interested in. You save time by not needing to visit each site individually as the information is delivered regularly. Communiqués	The department issues communiqués on behalf of industry groups and to provide information on state or national issues. Subjects of communiqués include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • commodities • industry updates • pests, diseases and weeds. Online communiqués are issued when a decision has been reached or is part of an ongoing action being implemented.	A list of communiqués are available on the department's website .
Social Media 	The department maintains a social media presence on Twitter, Facebook and YouTube to support the communities we serve.	A list of social media accounts is available on the department's website .
