

# Australian Customs Notice No. 2020/12

### Amendments to Schedule 4 of the *Customs Tariff Act* 1995 Item 1 by-law

#### Schedule 4, Item 1 – Revocation and replacement of by-law 1919366

Item 1 of Schedule 4 of the *Customs Tariff Act 1995* provides a free rate of duty for goods prescribed by by-law that are:

- Scientific instruments or apparatus to which Annex D to the Educational, Scientific and Cultural Materials Agreement (Florence 1950) or Annex D to the Educational, Scientific and Cultural Materials Protocol (Nairobi 1976) applies; or
- Of a scientific nature and covered by an agreement or arrangement between the Government of Australia and the government of another country or other countries on cooperation in the field of science and technology.

Prescribed by-law 1919366 will be revoked and reissued as by-law 2000668 (Attachment A). By-law 2000668 updates Paragraph 2, Table A, to include the following organisations authorised to use the by-law:

- Ear Science Institute Australia
- Olivia Newton John Cancer Research Institute
- Murdoch Children's Research Institute
- Neuroscience Research Australia
- Translational Research Institute
- Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre
- ANZAC Research Institute
