

Victorian Freight and Logistics Industry Transport Alert

1 June 2022

Transport Alert – Wide load to move across city overnight and regional Victoria.

Drivers may face delays on several arterial roads between the city and New South Wales border on June 7 and 9 as two wide loads make their way between the Port of Melbourne and Tocumwal via Shepparton.

The loads measure 8 metres wide, 5.2 metres high, each with a mass of 87.5 tonnes and will consist of large dump trucks which are used in the mining industry.

Two trucks will leave the Port of Melbourne at **12am 7 June** and another two at **12am 9 June**.

Delays are expected so please plan ahead and where possible seek an alternative route. Roads that will be impacted include

- Koorringa Way,
- Webb Dock Drive,
- West Gate Fwy,
- Western Ring Rd,
- Metropolitan Ring Rd,
- Hume Fwy,
- Goulburn Valley Fwy,
- Goulburn Valley Hwy and the Shepparton Alternative Route via River Rd Kialla,
- Doyles Rd Shepparton, and
- Grahamvale Rd Congupna.

The trucks will be travelling through Shepparton around 10am – midday on both days, which may cause some delays to travel.

The loads will travel at about 60km/h and there will be limited opportunities to overtake.

We ask drivers to allow extra time, avoid the wide-load route where possible, and to follow the direction of traffic controllers escorting the load.
