

Construct an Illegal Logging Due Diligence System (DDS)

From 1 January 2018 companies must have a documented due diligence system (DDS) to meet the requirements of the Commonwealth Illegal Logging Prohibition Act and Regulation 2012.

This is part of a growing compliance and control environment that will continue to increase in complexity, especially under the anticipated Australia-European Union Free Trade Agreement.

3D Logistics in association with BDO will be running 2 half day workshops business to take them through process of constructing a DDS to meet this legislation.

As part of our presentation, we will explain the emerging commercial and regulatory issues at the border and how the DDS can provide a general model for dealing with compliance and control issues as they develop.
