

## **Export Air Cargo Security is changing on 1 March 2019**

Dear Exporters,

I am writing to you with information critical to the future of your export business.

It is just under **three (3) months until 1 March 2019** when export air cargo, regardless of destination, will need to be examined at piece-level or originate from a Known Consignor.

This change is necessary to ensure that Australia is responding to the evolving terrorist threat.

## If you haven't already done so, please talk to your air cargo supply chain about:

If and how the change will impact your current export arrangements.

## For example:

- Possible changes to delivery times or delays
- o Possible increases in costs
- Your options to minimise the impact of the change.

Think about things like:

- Packaging of your products
- Handling of consolidated cargo
- Scheduling of your deliveries
- How your cargo is transported
- Considerations for your business becoming a Known Consignor.
