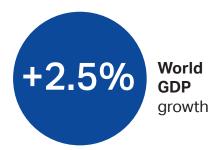

Weakness in international trade impacted the most the Asia Pacific region - one of the world's main manufacturing and distribution hubs. Its air freight volumes fell by nearly 6% year-on-year in 2019.
