



## How to login to Learnhub

Accredited persons can access class 19 continued biosecurity competency activities and other class 19 Automatic Entry Processing (AEP) resources through our Learnhub platform.

### Create a password and login to Learnhub

- 1) To access Learnhub, visit the following link or type it directly into the address bar of your internet browser: <https://learnhub.agriculture.gov.au>

*Note: we recommend you bookmark this site for quick access.*

- 2) Under the **Manual Login** field, click the **Forgot your password** button. This allows you to setup a password for the first time or create a new password.




## Accessing Learnhub Tip Sheet

- 3) Type your email address into the **Enter your username** and **Confirm your username** fields.

*Note: Your username/email is the unique email address that is registered with the department. If you are unsure of your registered email, please contact [AEPsupport@aff.gov.au](mailto:AEPsupport@aff.gov.au).*



- 4) Click the **Send reset email** button to generate a password reset link.




- 5) Head to your email inbox and follow the email instructions to setup a new password. The process will redirect you back to the Learnhub login page, where you will be prompted to create a new password.
